



2011 RAYJUS OUTDOORS – OAK LAWN COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL BASS TOURNAMENT

Excitement was running high for over 120 high school anglers from across northern Illinois who assembled at the Des Plaines Conservation Area. [Rayjus Outdoors](#), [Unique Bassmasters](#) and [Spartan Fishing Team](#), partnered together to present the [2011 Rayjus Outdoors - Oak Lawn Community High School Bass Tournament](#) on the Kankakee/Des Plaines River at the Des Plaines Conservation Area. Twelve schools were represented in the tournament. Participating schools included Oak Lawn, Brother Rice, Minooka, Marist, Reavis, Lemont, Midland, Providence, Seneca, DeLaSalle, Downers Grove South, and Eureka High Schools.



In an effort to allow as many kids to participate in a high school bass tournament, schools were not limited to the number of boats they could enter. Parents, coaches, and volunteers came through for the kids and entered **34 boats**, giving many of these kids the opportunity to competitively bass fish for the first time! At registration, each student angler received a gift bag from [Rayjus Outdoors](#) containing a frisbee from [Mercury Marine](#) and sample baits from [Dragin' Bait Company](#), [Bizz Baits](#), [HylaBaits](#), and [Lake Fork Trophy Lures](#). The [US Air Force](#) was also present, hosting a casting competition for the kids.

With a weight of 8.90lbs, anglers **Nick Kirkton** and **Nick Stuedemann** of **Seneca High School** were this year's winning team. "The weather was perfect, the fishing was awesome, and we were just out there having fun" said coach **Andy Jackson** of their experience. The duo brought five largemouth bass to the scales.



Taking second place were freshmen anglers **John Neubauer** and **Andrew Jensen** of **Oak Lawn Community High School**. "We were fishing a weedy flat and we were working our baits hard. It took some work and a lot of patience to get those fish to bite, but it all paid off in the end" said **Jensen**. Boat driver **Al Brenicky** of Unique Bassmasters put the kids on some fish right from the start. On **Neubauer's** second cast of the morning, he landed a 14inch bass. "Mr. Brenicky taught us a technique called a wacky rig that Andy and I have never used before. We made some long casts and worked our baits over a weed edge to catch our limit. We were determined to catch fish," said Neubauer.



Rounding out the top three places was **Lemont High School's** team of **Chris Walter**, **Luke Jasper**, and **Paige Matijevich** with a weight of 5.38 pounds. For a second year in a row, **Chris Walter** caught the big bass of the tournament weighing 2.47 pounds.



The [US Air Force](#) sponsored a casting competition for the kids. **Robert Malloy** of **DeLaSalle High School** won



the competition and was awarded a trophy by Tactical Sargent Al Lomax.

“The turnout for this tournament and the results were awesome! We had a lot of great people and businesses come together for this event. I’d like to thank **Rayjus Outdoors**, the **Unique Bassmasters**, and the **Illinois Bass Federation Nation** for helping to organize this tournament and giving the kids this opportunity” said Oak Lawn fishing coach Chris Kuchyt.

Scott Orban, who helped organize the event and is a member of Unique Bassmasters stated “For two years in a row, this tournament has been one of the most rewarding days I have had on the water and I didn’t even make a cast! The opportunity to be part of this is certainly a privilege and my calendar is already marked for next year.”


